Judges must be WDAA members in good standing.

Show management must appoint a knowledgeable person to serve as the "designated person" to check and inspect tack in each class. This person will be responsible for overseeing the checking of tack, bits, etc. outside of the ring immediately following the completion of the test. A horse must be eliminated from the test just completed if the tack is in violation of the WDAA/USEF rules.
