

Q. What does WHLPAP stand for?

A. It is the acronym for the WDAA Horse Lifetime Points & Awards Program.

Q. Do I have to be a member of WDAA to enroll my horse in the WHLPAP?

A. Yes. If you are not a member yet, you can JOIN HERE.

Q. How do I enroll my horse in the WHLPAP?

A. Fill out a Lifetime Enrollment Form, available on the WHLPAP web page

(<https://westerndressageassociation.org/wdaa-horse-lifetime-points-and-awards-program/>)

Then submit the form with a \$100 enrollment fee.

Q. When will I receive an enrollment number for my horse?

A. As soon as possible (usually the same day or the next day), a certificate with your horse's enrollment number will be sent by email.

Q. The email I received following submission of a Lifetime Enrollment Form indicates I must submit a form and fee for each year I plan to submit scores into the program. Do I have to submit these for the year the horse is enrolled?

A. Yes, if the horse is competing in recognized shows the year of its enrollment.

Q. If I enroll my horse in the program in 2018, can I still submit scores from recognized shows I attended in 2017?

A. Yes, you can. We accept scores from the previous year as long as you pay the annual recording fee for that year.

Q. How do I know whether a show I am attending or would like to attend is a WDAA Recognized Show?

A. All WDAA Recognized Shows are listed on the WDAA calendar available on the home page of the WDAA website.

Q. Where do I find the WDAA Recognized Show number at the show?

A. We have requested that shows post the show number in a conspicuous place, but if you don't see it at the show, you can find it on the WDAA calendar, which lists all WDAA Recognized Shows with the number.

Q. If someone else will be riding my horse in tests or classes at WDAA recognized shows that I plan to submit for points, do they have to be a member of WDAA?

A. Yes.

Q. Do I have to fill out a separate test form for each test I ride at a show?

A. No, but a separate form must be completed if a different rider rides some tests on your horse at the same show. You can fill out up to 8 tests for each horse/rider combination on each form. After completing the first row, click the plus sign at the end of the row for a new row to be added. Enter test levels and test numbers (as numerals) without any additional text (See example below).

Enter class, judge, test level (Intro, Basic, 1, 2, or 3), test NUMBER, score, and %. Click the plus sign (+) to add up to 8 rows.

Press + sign at end of each new row to enter up to 8 tests for one show
